LUC BOSSUYT/BRISTOL-MYERS SQUIBB SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Luc Bossuyt/Bristol-Myers Squibb Scholarship Fund was established as a scholarship fund for graduate students studying structural biology at the University of California, Davis. This travel award (up to \$3,000) will be used to attend key presentations and conferences and to present research findings when appropriate.

Eligibility

Applications will be accepted from graduate students in the Center for Structural Biology, a collaborative program between the College of Biological Sciences and the Department of Chemistry. Graduate students who plan to attend an international conference and/or symposia in the field of structural biology are eligible. Students must be in good academic standing and are required to hold and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0. Applicants must be full-time, registered graduate students.

Application Process

Interested students are asked to submit the following application materials:

- Copy of registration confirmation
- A list of applicant's publications and awards (if applicable)
- A copy of academic record or transcript (sisweb NOT accepted)
- A letter of recommendation from major professor

Application deadline: Applications for travel during July 1 through December 31 are due to by June 1st. For travel during January 1 through June 30, applications are due December 1st.
